PATH is a set of computer-based, interactive self-help tools and is offered through a research study at the Geisel School of Medicine at Dartmouth

1. Open a web browser and navigate to **path.dartmouth.edu**

2. Select the green **Signup** button

3. Create your account by including:

- A username with at least 8 characters. This cannot be an email and should not identify you (e.g. not your name, nickname, etc.)
- Password with at least 8 characters, 1 uppercase, 1 lowercase, 1 digit (e.g. 1, 2, 3..), and 1 special character (e.g. @\$%^&...)
- Choose a security question and enter your answer. This will be used to unlock your account if you forget your password.
- Use the token _____ if you have been given one or select "I don't have a token"
- Enter your age and gender
- Complete the reCAPTCHA (the "I am not a robot" question). This helps keep our system secure.

We recommend that you save your credentials. Here is a place that you can write them if you would like:
